What can you book an interpreter for?

Under the National Sign Language Program, Deaf Connect provides free interpreters and live captioning for a range of social activities and essential appointments for older Australians, including:

ESSENTIAL ACTIVITIES

- · Medical appointments
- · Banking, superannuation & budgeting
- · Downsizing, selling or moving home
- · Online activities & meetings
- · Talking to your internet or phone provider

SOCIAL ACTIVITIES

- · Weddings, funerals and family reunions
- · Theater and events
- · Seniors activities, clubs or groups

What services are available?

In-person and online interpreting appointments are available 7 days a week (after-hours when required) and live captioning.
