Supports for clients and participants will be maintained under the Deaf Connect brand.

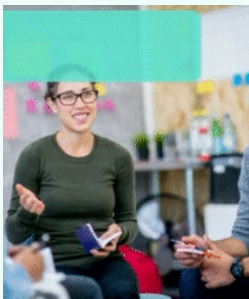

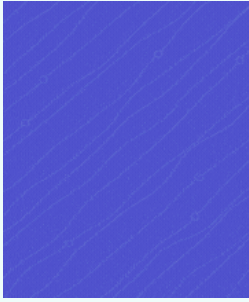
