SOCIAL SKILLS PROGRAM

Facilitated by our Therapy and Family Services team, our groups help deaf and hard of hearing children build communication, fine motor, social, and emotional skills through Lego! Children will:

- Develop social skills and make new friends
- Be introduced to Deaf culture and Auslan from a Deaf model (Teacher of the Deaf, Allied Health Assistant or Deaf Family mentor)
- Develop social problem-solving skills and manage conflict with peers
- Develop communication skills in a social context using your language preference (Auslan, Spoken English, visual communication).

Roles include:

-  Builder
-  Engineer, or
-  Part Supplier

Program Details

For deaf and hard of hearing children, their siblings and CODAs aged 5-12. The program is run by Allied Health therapists and a Deaf model. Auslan interpreters are also present.

Duration: The program runs for 3 days, 2 hours sessions each day.

Cost: Pricing is dependent on final group size. NDIS funding can also be utilised.
