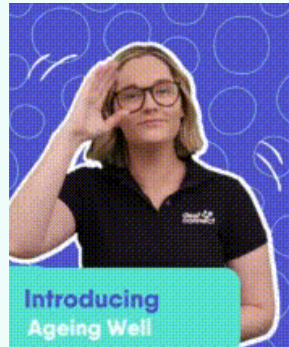

As a carer it's also important to prioritise your own wellbeing. Our blog below discusses five ways to care for yourself while you care for your loved ones.

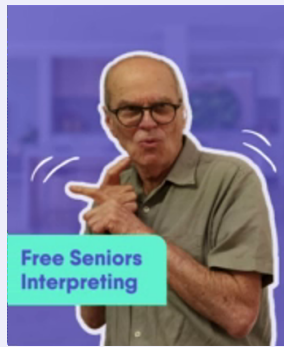

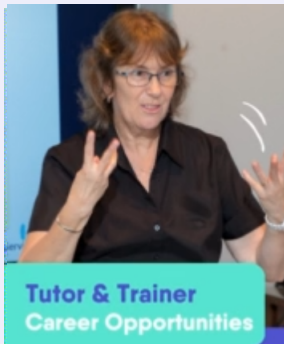
