Learn how to use technology, stay safe online, and build confidence with digital tools in this 9-week course. The course is delivered in Auslan by a Deaf trainer.

You will learn:

- How to use technology/AI tools to complete simple tasks
- How to complete a digital form
- How to stay safe online
- How to open and respond to emails

This course is free. To be eligible, you must:

- Be Deaf
- Be 17 years or older
- Not be enrolled in, or attending, a school, college, or another program that leads to completing Year 12
- Live in the ACT
- Be one of the following:
 - An Australian or New Zealand citizen, or
 - A permanent resident, or
 - A migrant, refugee, or asylum seeker with a temporary or bridging visa that allows work and/or study

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
